Water conservation is vital

Our only source of water is an underground aquifer that is not unlimited. Excessive lawn irrigation is the number one cause of low water pressure.

Hot temperatures can significantly increase water demand and it is vital that we all play a role in conserving. Water providers across Long Island are reminding customers to use water wisely and help preserve this critical resource so we can maintain a reliable supply for everyone, especially for fire emergencies.

Key reminders:

- Nassau County prohibits lawn watering between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Follow the odd/even address watering schedule.
- Focus water use on trees and shrubs.
- Lawns only need about one inch of water per week.
