Don't Use the toilet as a garbage can.

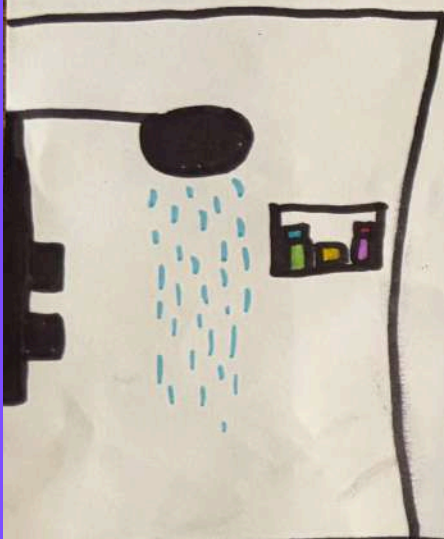
