- **Monitor your usage with My Account** – Track your usage with easy-to-read graphs, helping you better control your usage.
- **Look for leaks** – Leaks are sneaky and can waste a lot of water over a short period of time, adding up to wasted money. Regularly check faucets, toilets, shower heads, and irrigation systems for leaks and repair them to help save.
- **Water responsibly** – Avoid runoff from your sprinklers by turning sprinkler heads toward your lawn or garden, not the sidewalk or your driveway.
- **Invest in smart tools** – Smart irrigation controllers use technology to help you save.

Your warm weather watering schedule

Water conservation is important for the environment, which is why Nassau County has restrictions in place on lawn watering.

- Lawn watering between 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. is prohibited.
- Even-numbered addresses and non-numbered homes can water only on even-numbered days.
- Odd-numbered addresses can water only on odd-numbered days.
- Follow the Automatic Systems Zoned Map Schedule to relieve system strains during the summer peak mornings due to irrigation systems. You can access this schedule by visiting www.libertyenergyandwater.com and selecting "Irrigation Guidelines" located under the "Smart Water Use" drop-down menu or by scanning the QR code below.
- If manually irrigating, each zone/area should not run more than 15 minutes.

In addition to saving water and reducing strain on our distribution system, these guidelines also reduce the likelihood of overwatering, resulting in a healthier, more attractive landscape.
