Eligibility

- Students in grades 9-12 living in or attending a high school within the Liberty service territories are eligible. Entries can be submitted by an individual or team.
- One entry per person or team.
- All contestants under the age of 18 must have parent/guardian consent to participate.

Media Art Guidelines

- Videos must focus on water conservation and address the theme.
- Videos may be up to one minute in length (no more) and be appropriate for all ages. Videos over 60 seconds will be disqualified.
- Videos should be shot in horizontal (landscape) format.
- Video resolution should not be above 1920x1080 HD. Please do not submit 4K (UHD) or higher.
- Student(s) may use the camera and software of their choice to create the video.
- If your video includes a language other than English, it must include English subtitles.
- Videos may not use copyrighted images or music.
- Videos must not infringe on the privacy or personal rights of any person alive or deceased.
- By entering, you grant Liberty non-exclusive ownership of the video. We can use it on our social media, website, or elsewhere, but the creator can also continue to use it.

Submission

- If multiple students are involved in one film, each participant must submit separate entry forms specifying which film title they are associated with.
- Submission deadline extended to April 29, 2024.

Judging

- The judges will consider creative vision, artistic talent, an understanding of the value of water and an ability to communicate the theme to determine the finalists.
- Finalist's videos will be posted on Liberty New York Water's Facebook page and the video with the most "points" will win. Points will be awarded as follows: 1 point for every like; 2 points for every share. The videos with the most points will be awarded first, second and third place respectively.
- Liberty reserves the right to not award a winner if no entry merits such designation.
