Low-income programs are here to help

Liberty's Customer Assistance Program (CAP) is designed to provide payment assistance to low-income customers. The program consists of two sub-programs: an Arrearage Management Program (AMP) and a Low-Income Bill Discount Program. AMP provides eligible, low-income, residential water customers with arrearage forgiveness up to \$1,200 per year as long as they are on this program. The Low-Income Bill Discount Program provides eligible customers with a credit equal to the monthly meter charge (not greater than the 1" monthly charge).
