Tips For a Healthy Lawn

Have you ever wondered how much water your grass needs to stay healthy? Experts say one inch of water per week is all it takes! But how long does a sprinkler need to run to apply an inch of water? On average, it takes two to three hours. The following is a good way to check the amount of water applied:

- Place small, straight-sided containers at different intervals in the sprinkling area.
- · Catch the water for an hour.
- Measure the depth of water with a ruler (all levels should be the same).

Over watering your lawn can cause shallow roots, nutrient loss, weed growth, and other problems. Install a sensor to measure rain levels and use a water gauge. **Scan the QR code** below to view lawn irrigation guidelines. And don't forget - if it rains, you don't need to water your lawn!
