We care about the environment, and water conservation is a big part of that. From finding and correcting leaks to using less water to care for your lawn, every drop makes a difference.

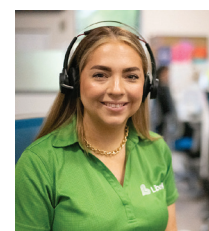
You can start by using our leak detection checklist, requesting a free leak detection kit and ensuring that your home or business is not using excessive water because of leaks.

The average household leak wastes approximately 10,000 gallons of water – that's the amount of water in a typical home swimming pool. You can also install WaterSense labeled showerheads and faucets and energy efficient washing machines and dishwashers to reduce your use.

We care about – Protecting your pipes

There are different opinions on winter weather, but one thing we can all agree on is that frozen pipes can ruin a perfectly good day. Follow these tips to protect your pipes and help keep your home warm, dry, and safe.



Indoor tips:

- Keep the temperature in your home or business 55 degrees or warmer.
- Wrap your pipes with insulation.
- If pipes run through cabinets, leave the cabinet doors open to let warmer air in.
- During periods of an extended freeze, let a slow drip of water flow to keep the water running through the pipes.

Outdoor tips:

- Ensure sprinkler systems are turned off and drained.
- Know the location of your main water valve and how to turn it off.
- Disconnect all hoses and drain water remaining in faucets.
- Cover or insulate outdoor faucets.
- Check any water lines leading to unheated structures.
- Insulate or wrap heat tape around any exposed pipes.

If your pipes do freeze, shut off the water immediately and thaw pipes with a hair dryer or space heater. Do not leave space heaters unattended and do not use open flames. Once pipes are thawed, slowly turn water on and check pipes and joints for any cracks.
